

Launched in November 2021, UK I DFF (UK India Diabetic Foot Foundation) is a mission-driven program designed to combat the growing challenges of diabetic foot complications.

It is a community-centered awareness initiative.

The first camp, held on January 20, 2024, marked the beginning of a mission to transform diabetic foot care education and prevention.

UK I DFF is proud to be pioneering the first-ever initiative of its kind in India. With no specialized clinics focusing on diabetic foot care in the country, our camp is filling a crucial gap in healthcare, providing expert care, screening, and education to those who need it most.

To expand our impact, we have a highly experienced doctor from the UK specializing in diabetic foot treatment. Under his guidance, we plan to train more local doctors, equipping them with the necessary skills to provide this treatment. Our goal is to make specialized care more accessible, ensuring that diabetic foot complications are addressed proactively, preventing the need for amputations.



The initiative is driven by a diverse team of 40 diabetic foot specialists and doctors from the UK, UAE, and India. **Its inaugural camp, held on January 20, 2024**, brought together top professionals, including:

- **Apollo Hospital Jubilee Hills, Hyderabad: Led by Dr. Srinivas Seshabattar.**
- **Dr. Varma Group of Hospitals, Bhimavaram: Led by Dr. Varma.**
- **Imperial Hospital, Bhimavaram: Led by Dr. Naresh.**

The first camp was **attended by an impressive 1,500 individuals**, who benefited from the following services:

- Comprehensive diabetic foot screenings.
- Free distribution of essential medicines.
- Expert advice on diabetic foot protection and care.
- Advanced wound treatment and personalized wound care guidance.





As we prepare for our 2025 camp in Bhimavaram, we are committed to setting even higher goals, reaching more individuals, and expanding the impact of our efforts. Health is our number one priority, and through continued partnerships, we will drive forward our mission to prevent diabetic foot complications and improve lives across India.
